Camp Northland is the largest Jewish community overnight camp in Ontario with its origins dating back to 1909. We are committed to making residential camp accessible to children and young adults in partnership with the Jewish community, and are dedicated to providing a fun and safe environment for campers and staff to build their Jewish identity, a love of nature, connections to Israel, positive relationships, life skills and independence.

Jewish camping has a large and undeniable influence on building Jewish identity. Research has proven that children with positive Jewish experiences become adults who value their Jewish heritage, support Jewish causes, and take on leadership roles in their community. The impact of Jewish summer camp is clear, and the opportunity to increase that impact dramatically is significant. Camp Northland is a not-for-profit Jewish community camp operated by the Jewish Camp Council of Toronto. Our camp provides children, ages 6-17, with an amazing blend of opportunities and programs while building Jewish identity and pride. Camp Northland continues to expand its mandate to provide childrens' camping services to the Jewish community regardless of a family's financial circumstance by providing subsidies to those in need. Our goal is to reach even more deserving children, while ensuring we offer premiere camping and first class service and amenities to families that make Camp Northland their first choice without the need for financial support.

Camp Northland-B'nai Brith has undergone a dramatic and well documented turn-around and resurgence in recent years. Enrollment has been growing year over year for

5 years. Donations have grown. The organization has been reinvesting in infrastructure, programming, staff development and facilities and has established a new narrative which focuses on a long-term culture of Tzedakah and a down to earth values based camp for our entire community. Our professional staff is setting standards in all areas of Camp operations, for camper care and staff training. It's a wonderful time to get involved. We are continually looking to strengthen our diverse board and encourage applicants from across all areas of our community whether you have children or not or your children go or went to Camp Northland or not. Your influence and efforts can make a huge impact.

The Jewish Camp Council is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and operates with the support of numerous additional volunteers on a number of committees.
